— *2net Hub Software Release and New Qualcomm Life Ecosystem Collaboration Announced at HIMSS 2014* —

ORLANDO AND SAN DIEGO — February 24, 2014 — Qualcomm Incorporated (NASDAQ: QCOM) today announced that its subsidiary, [Qualcomm Life, Inc.](#), is integrating Bluetooth Low Energy (BLE), as part of the latest 2net™ Hub software release, making the 2net Hub one of the first standalone, FDA-listed wireless gateways on the market that can seamlessly connect to BLE-enabled medical and fitness devices¹.
